Meeting at Swampscott High School for grade 8 parents	 Override process will be reviewed. Computer lab will be open at 7:00 pm and staffed for families who wish to have assistance logging on, how to choose an elective, and learning more about Aspen. The presentation and documents from tonight will be available for families on the SHS website the following day.
March 30-April 7	Aspen portal is open for students in grade 8 to choose ONE elective and ONE alternate. Electives do not include required courses such as health, PE, writing, and computer applications.
Friday, April 12	Override process forms must be submitted to the main office of SMS before April 12, 2017.
On or before May 5	HS principal reviews override requests & informs family of decision. Counselors at SHS will make changes to Aspen to reflect decision.
Monday, May 8	High School master scheduling begins.
Friday, June 2	SHS step up day- all grade 8 students attending SHS in the fall report to the high school for the day.
